Well, winter has finally appeared. We have had a nice warm season so far but it is going to get cold outside. With this in mind, we want to remind you of a few items that come along with the winter season.

- 1) If there is a fire hydrant near your property, please dig it out of the snow so the firemen can access it easily if they need to use it.
- 2) When removing snow from your driveway or sidewalk, please do not push it across the street on to someone else's property or into the street. Please pile it on your property.
- 3) Alternate side parking - Park for the next day. Park on the odd numbered street side on the odd number day of the month. Even side of the street on the even number day of the month. Your vehicle must be on the correct side of the street as of midnight each night. After midnight, if your vehicle is on the wrong side of the street, you will be ticketed. This applies at all times during the alternate side parking from November 15 – April 15. It does not matter if we have snow or not. If you do not comply, you could be ticketed more than once if your vehicle is not moved. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

Hours of Operation for the recycling center are Tuesday 9:00am - 3:00pm, Thursday 2:00pm – 6:00pm and Saturday 9:00am – 3:00pm. The recycling building is located behind the Woodford State Bank.

Village/Township bags can be purchased at the South Wayne Mart and the recycling center at a cost of \$2.00/bag. Recycling is FREE; your garbage has the cost. Please do not put recyclable items in the garbage bags. Garbage is picked up by the Village on Wednesday's every week.

Community Park – As always, we appreciate everyone's support for the improvement of the park. We have had some vandalism in the park to the new restrooms. If you have any information on this, we would truly appreciate you informing Officer Conway. Because of such incidents and to keep our park clean, safe and in good repair, we have installed security cameras in key locations. The Park Committee is also moving forward with putting an addition on the east end of the shelter house with a cooler being installed and more electrical outlets, storage, etc. for events such as weddings and family reunions. This should make it more convenient for additional events to also be held. Reservations of the park can be done through Roger Trame.

Street Construction 2017 – We have been approved for all of our grant applications through the State and we will be moving forward in 2017 with reconstruction of Grove Street (CTH “D” to Wyota Street), McKnight Street (STH “11” to High Street), and Pleasant Street (Verley Street to McKnight Street). Hopefully construction will be completed by October of 2017.

As we progress in improving our streets, we have all noticed that several mature trees were removed from the terrace. If you have had trees removed and would like to plant young trees, the Village Board is requesting that you come to us for approval of the trees to be planted as we want to have terrace approved trees planted to insure that we can keep the sidewalks, streets and water/sewer lines in good repair by having smaller trees planted. Thank you for understanding our situation.
