There will be no exceptions for late sign up as there will be an additional \$25 fee charged. Regular fee is \$25 per child. Over the past couple of years the WI DNR in conjunction with FEMA has been working to update the Flood Insurance Rate Maps for Lafayette County. You are invited to come see the proposed floodplain maps at the Darlington Town Bank on Thursday, April 11th at 6:00 pm in the Lower Level Conference Room at 15815 Hwy 81, Darlington, WI 53530. The WI DNR and FEMA are hosting this event. Please come get your Lafayette County floodplain questions answered.

ATV ROUTES OPEN – The streets are open in the Village from April 1st – November 15th from 5:00 am – 1:00 am. The speed limit is 10 MPH. You can travel from your home to the trail but **should** not be used as a mode of transportation from house to house.

RECYCLING/GARBAGE BAGS – Garbage bags are \$2 per bag and can be purchased from the South Wayne Mart or the Recycling Center behind the Mart. Recycling Center is open Tuesday and Saturday from 9:00 am – 3:00 pm and Thursday from 2:00 pm – 6:00 pm. There is no charge for recycling products. You can get a recycling information sheet from the Village by calling 608-439-1011, we will mail you one or you can get one at the Recycling Center.

HOW TO GET TO THE RECYCLING CENTER - Please refrain from using the driveway straight off of Galena Street and across from Highway 11. This is a private drive and it is considered trespassing. The Village or Town of Wayne does not own that driveway. Please use County D to get to the Recycling Center and exit by way of County D.

DUMPSTER - When you get a dumpster, please remember that the dumpster is considered full when you can close the lids properly. If the dumpster is over full and lids do not close properly, you may be responsible for an additional charge or not allowed to rent another dumpster.

REMINDERS

The Village Board meets on the 2nd Wednesday of each month at 7:00 pm at the Fire Station.

Open burning is prohibited in the Village.

Building permits are required by Ordinance. Contact the clerk's office at 608-439-1011.

All houses in the Village are required to have a house number above or at the side of the entrance door so the number can be seen plainly from the street.

Dogs are not allowed to run at large. Use a collar and leash when walking your dog. Do not allow it free access to the street. Please carry a "poop bag" to pick up after your dog. Your neighbors will appreciate it. Three dogs are allowed per household. All dogs need a dog license, contact Judy Meske at 608-439-5377 to obtain your dog license.

As Spring/Summer approaches, please be reminded that grass clippings should not be blown or raked into the streets. You can dispose of grass clippings by taking them to the Village Quarry south of town off of County D. There is a Compost Site there.

Leaves can be raked into the streets for the sweeper to pick up or you can dispose of them at the compost site. Please do not put sticks/stones etc. in with the leaves. This will cause damage to the sweeper.
